Dear Parents and Carers,

It was good to see so many of you at Parents Evening the week before half term. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or were unable to come to the meeting and discuss your child's progress.

Welcome back to Spring 2, it is a short five-week half term until we break up for Easter. Our PE days will stay the same, Tuesdays and Thursdays. We have a tennis unit and an orienteering unit which will hopefully be fun!

In Maths we are continuing to work on perimeter and area before starting to work on Fractions. Children can find fractions quite tricky to start with so please do ask your children about their learning and understanding of this topic and let me know if you need any help. After that we will do a measuring unit on mass and capacity.

Enchanted Forest Tales is our theme, we will be studying a Geography unit about Rainforests and our English work is also based around this topic. Our first Writing Root focuses on a book called The Wilderness and our second is a book called Winter's Child. Our guided reading books are A necklace of raindrops which is a collection of modern fairytales and then we will read The Lost Spells which is a beautifully illustrated collection of poems and spells about nature, including birds, trees, animals and moths. In Science we will be learning about plants. In addition, there will be music with a rainforest theme, and art will focus on the fabric of nature and creating patterns inspired by nature.

The children are enjoying our French lessons, this term we will be doing a unit about animals and learning lots of new French vocabulary to describe them.

Our sharing assembly is on Friday March 6th. We look forward to showing you our work that afternoon.
