LITERACY & READING

In writing, the children will be writing a narrative, a letter and a riddle poem.

During whole class guided reading, we will be looking at 'Too Small Tola' by Atinuke. The children will read this book a range of ways: listening to the teacher, reading with peers and echoing what the teacher reads.

MATHS

At the start of this term, the children will be focusing on place value and understanding numbers within 20. We will focus on understanding how many tens and ones each number has. After this, we will move onto addition and subtraction within 20, with a specific focus of number bonds.

FOUNDATION SUBJECTS

In History, the children will be looking at their own personal chronology and exploring how we remember significant events. In Art, we will be focusing on a key artist: Bridget Riley. The children will be learning how to create different lines through mark making, which will then be applied to observational drawing. In PE, the children will be developing their attacking and defensive skills in game situations.

SCIENCE

In science, the children will be learning about the 5 senses and how they impact the body.

PE AND BEACH SCHOOL

The children have beach school on Thursday afternoons and PE on Friday afternoons.

HOME READING

In line with the Little Wandle Reading Scheme, all reading books will be changed on a Friday, unless they are a free reader. The children would have read the book three times in school before it is sent home on a Friday.
